Introduction

Hook- say something interesting related to the topic to get the reader’s attention. Eg. use a famous quotation “ Martin Luther King Jr once said....” or use an interesting fact “ Before vaccines were invented, over 10,000 people died each day from disease”

Background information - Introduce the topic and say why you are writing about it. Eg. In the last few years many people have begun to speak out about vaccines, because they believe that they do more harm than good. There is a growing call for the government to end mandatory vaccinations.

Over the last 50 years, there have been more than 100 new vaccines, and people believe that this has helped to make the world a better place.

Thesis - States the topic of your essay, your point of view on the topic, and the specific evidence or arguments that you will discuss.

(In this essay, I will explain why vaccines are important)

Vaccines are essential because they improve the morbidity and mortality rate, prevent chaos and confusion, and they help protect those who cannot be vaccinated. (It helps to protect the economy)

Body Paragraph 1

Topic sentence - Vaccines help to protect people from getting very ill or even dying from serious diseases. According to Plotkin and Rodrigues “The most significant impact of vaccines has been to prevent morbidity and mortality from serious infections that disproportionately affect children.” There are many illnesses that can make not only children, but even adults very sick. Without vaccines, they would have little chance of surviving and living a healthy life. For example before the covid- 19 vaccine was created more than 10 million people died as a result of the disease. Oliver Watson PhD reports that the covid

19- vaccine has prevented at least 14.5 million deaths. Without the vaccine millions of people would continue to die every year.
