ESLDO - Unit 1



NOUN /noun/

- A word (other than a pronoun) used to identify any of a class of people, places, or things.
- Also known as a “proper noun”



VERB */verb/*

- A word that expresses an action (to run), occurrence (to happen), or state of being (to appear).



PRONOUN /pro-noun/

- A word that is used instead of a noun or noun phrase
- Pronouns sometimes refer to either a noun that has already been mentioned
- Some examples are: mine, yours



ADJECTIVE /ad-jek-tiv/

- A word you use to describe a person, place, or thing



ADVERB /ad-verb/

- A word that describes a verb (he sings loudly)
- A word that describes an adjective (very tall)
- A word that describes another **adverb** (ended too quickly)



TRANSITION WORD

/tran-zi-SHun/

- A word that helps connect or link ideas, phrases, sentences, or paragraphs
