- Awards
- Work Samples
- Works in Progress
- Assessments
- Letters of Recommendation
- Letters of Appreciation
- A list of professional Memberships and Certifications
- Descriptions of Community Involvement / Volunteer Activities

Using ONLINE e-Portfolio tools, you will be able to put together a simple website that presents your selected artifacts in a professional manner that you can take with you when you graduate. You will have the option to share your e-Portfolio with future employers.
