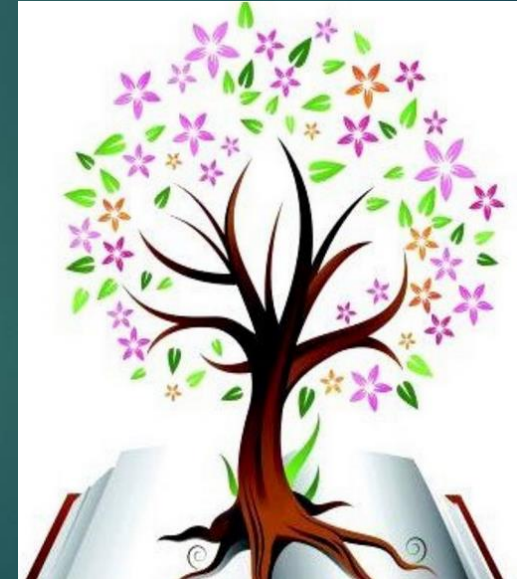

Self-introduction in an interview

- ▶ What are you supposed to do before an interview?
- ▶ What are you supposed to do during an interview?
- ▶ What are you expected to do after an interview?
- ▶ What are expected to cover in your self-introduction? How do you introduce yourself effectively in an interview?

How to Introduce Yourself in an Interview

- ▶ **Step 1:** Greet Your Interviewers
- ▶ **Step 2:** Let Your Interviewers Know About Your Educational Background, Qualifications, and Work experience – **Connect your experiences to the role**
- ▶ **Step 3:** A Line or Two on Your Passions and Hobbies, Values, & Future plans – **Showcase your willingness to learn and grow; Demonstrate your alignment with the company**
- ▶ **Step 4:** The Vital Closing Statement – Conclude with a positive note

Samples - sentences:

- ▶ **Sample 1:** "Hello, I am [Name], and I am delighted to be here today. I appreciate the opportunity to discuss my qualifications for the [Position/Job Title] role."
- ▶ **Sample 2:** "I am passionate about [Field] and am driven to excel in this industry. My experience in [Skills/Qualifications] has equipped me with the necessary tools to be an asset to this company."
- ▶ **Sample 3:** "I share the company's values of [Goal/Value] and am eager to be a part of a team that shares my commitment to making a positive impact in the industry."
- ▶ **Sample 4:** "Based on my qualifications and experience, I am confident that I am an excellent candidate for this position. I am eager to learn more about the company's vision and goals and how I can contribute to its success."
