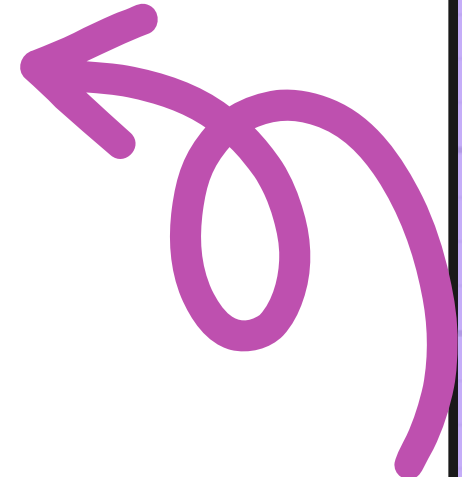


WHY OLC40?

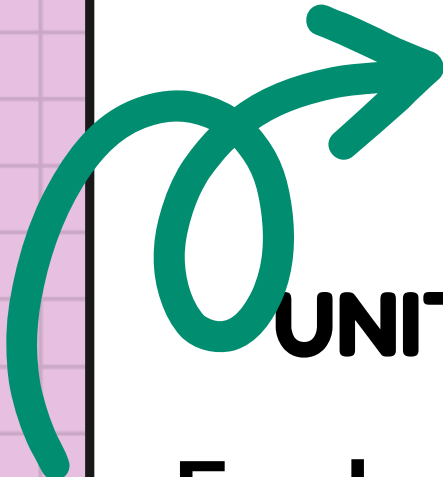

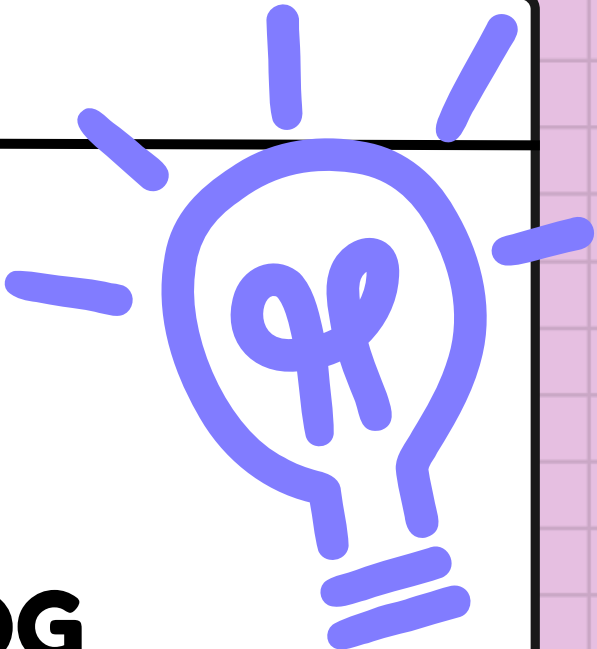

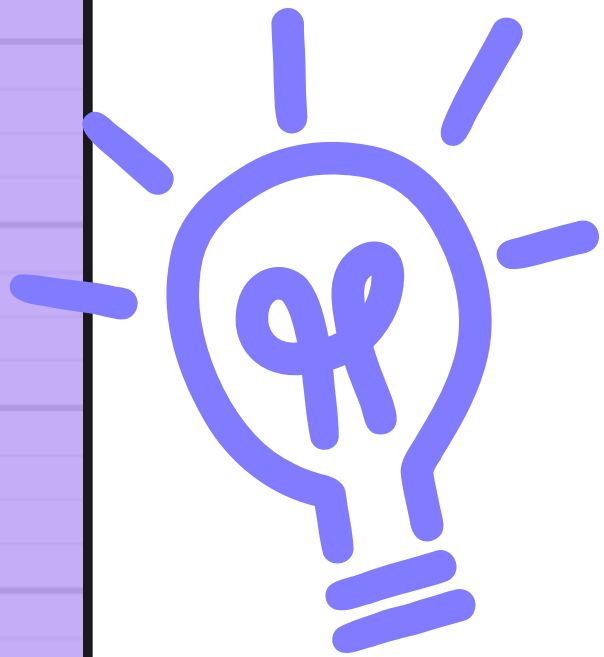
UNIT COMPLETION

Each unit is locked. You must achieve a minimum of 55% in unit assessments before you are allowed to begin the next unit.

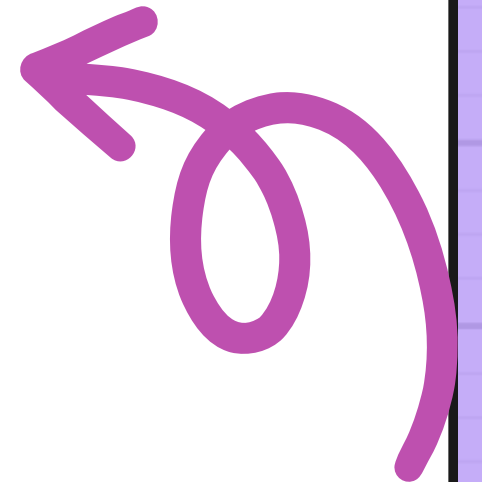


TIME LOG

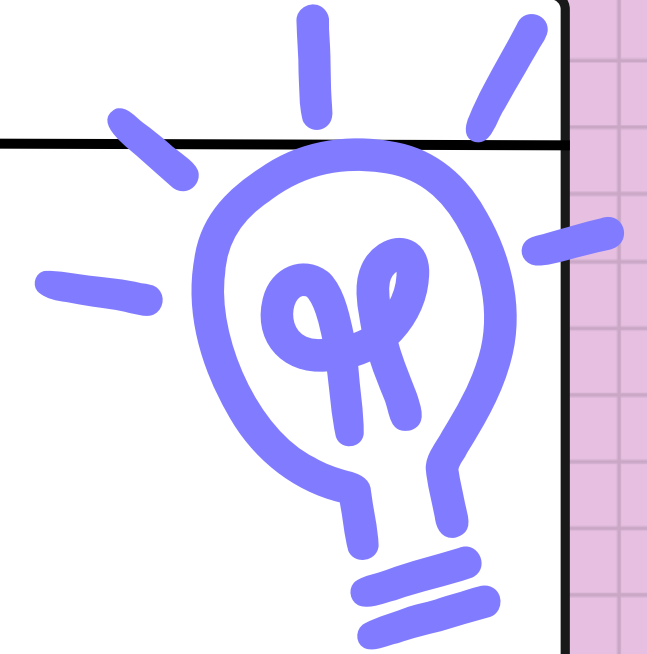
