Adapt	To adjust or change in response to new conditions or circumstances.
Consequences	The results or effects that happen as a result of a particular action or event.
Insecurity	A feeling of uncertainty or lack of confidence.
Deforestation	The clearing or destruction of forests, usually to make way for agricultural or urban development.
Emissions	Gases or particles released into the atmosphere, often as a result of human activities.

Erosion	The gradual wearing away or destruction of something, typically by wind, water, or other natural agents.
Efficient	Performing or functioning in the best possible manner with the least waste of time, effort, or resources.
Ecosystems	A community of organisms and their physical environment, interacting as a system.

Unlimited	Having no limits or restrictions.
Disaster	An event or occurrence causing widespread destruction and distress.
Agriculture	The practice of cultivating soil, growing crops, and raising livestock for food, fiber, and other products used to sustain human life.
Dairy	Related to milk or milk products, especially those made from cow's milk.
Greenhouse Gas	A gas in the atmosphere that traps heat and contributes to the greenhouse effect, resulting in global warming.

Zero Till Farming	A farming technique where the soil is left undisturbed by tilling or plowing, helping to preserve soil quality and reduce erosion.
Atmospheric Integrity	The state of the Earth's atmosphere being complete, intact, and free from pollutants or harmful substances.
PerCapita	Per person; for each individual.
Footprint	The environmental impact of a particular individual, organization, or community measured in terms of the amount of land and resources used.
Commitments	Promises or obligations to do something in the future.
