You'll be marked on the ENTIRE creative process - from the start of the assigned project, to the end. I'll be assessing your project at the various stages;

IMAGINING - PLANNING - EXPERIMENTING - REVISING - REFLECTING - PRESENTING

The following are general "LOOK FOR'S" for every project. Individual rubrics will be given with each assignment with more specific expectations for the units, but this gives you an idea of how to succeed;

KNOWLEDGE

-Applying the Rules of Theatre -> we'll be learning these soon

-Use of movement ("blocking")

-Costume, lighting, sound

THINKING

-Interpretation of script/ideas/feelings -Planning during the rehearsal process

COMMUNICATION

-Characterization - your use of facial expression, vocal expression, body expression

-Relationship dynamics (how you relate/re-act to other characters)

-Your focus and believability

APPLICATION

-Overall effectiveness of presentation

-Works as integral part of the group scene
