MOVEMENT	 The look or feeling of <u>action</u> A way to guide the viewer's eye in, through, and out of the artwork 	
CONTRAST	Opposites or differences between Elements of Art arranged together in an artwork or composition	
RHYTHM	 Elements of Art that <u>repeat</u> in an unorganized way a relationship between elements that creates a sense of harmony 	
UNITY	Unity refers to how different elements of an artwork or design come together and create a sense of wholeness	
EMPHASIS	 to draw the viewer's attention to a specific design element to create a focal point in the design an eye-catching part that stands out 	No. 50
BALANCE	the <u>equal</u> distribution of visual weight of objects colors, texture, and space in an artwork or composition 1. Symmetrical - elements are similar 2. Asymmetrical - elements are different 3. Radial - arranged around a central point
