# Activity: Create 6-Box Value Scale with Tints, Tones, and Shades

## **Objective:**

Students will create a value scale to understand and apply tints, shades, and tones,

with a specific explanation of how tones are made and used.

## Materials:

- Paints (choose one color, black, white, gray)
- Paintbrushes
- Ruler
- Paper
- Pencil

#### Steps:

### 1. Set Up Your Scale:

On your paper, draw a horizontal rectangle divided into **6 equal boxes**.

You need 3 boxes.

#### 2. Label the Boxes:

Box 1: "Tint"

Box 2: "Tone "

Box 3: "Shade"

#### 3. Fill Each Box:
