- When have you dressed a certain way in order to conform? How did you add to your dress to express your individuality while conforming?

Social (pages 22 to 24 of the student resource)

- Why is modesty important? What factors contribute to various degrees of modesty?

- When have you relied on someone's clothing to identify his or her occupation or role?
