Follow these steps while watching a video lecture or reading your textbook:

- 1. **Preview:** Skim through the chapter or video description to get an overview of key topics.
- **2. Active Listening / Reading:** Focus on main concepts, definitions, and explanations. Pause the video if needed to jot down key points.
- **3. Summarize in Your Own Words:** Avoid copying exactly the same words; instead, write the information in a way that makes sense to you.
- **4. Use Visuals:** Draw diagrams, charts, and mind maps to better understand complex concepts.
- **5. Highlight Key Terms & Questions**: Note down unfamiliar words or concepts to review later. You may use a highlighter or different colour.
- **6. Review & Revise:** After finishing, go through your notes and clarify any confusing points. Add missing details if necessary.
