What is the OSSLT?

- It is a test of **reading** and **writing** skills.
- It is based on the Ontario curriculum up to the end of **Grade 9**.



WHO?

- ALL Grade 10 students in Ontario MUST write the Ontario Secondary School Literacy Test (OSSLT).
- Rewriters or Gr.11 or Gr. 12 students who have not yet attempted the test before.

WHY?

- OSSLT is a GRADUATION requirement for all students!



WHEN?

Tuesday, April 8, 2025



WHERE?

- Students will write the OSSLT in
 - 1st Floor Room 102 & 103
 - 2nd Floor Big Hall

HOW?

- The OSSLT is 100% digital. You will complete all sections online, on your own laptop.
