Sentence Definition:

A **sentence** is a group of words that expresses a complete thought. It always has at least two core parts.

The two essential parts are:

1. Subject - who or what the sentence is about (Noun, Proper Noun, pronoun)
2. Predicate - what the subject is doing or being (Always starts with a Verb)

Example:

The dog barked.

Subject: The Dog

Predicate: barked.

Question: What makes a complete sentence?

Answer:

A complete sentence must have:

1. Make sense on its own.
2. Include a verb
3. Start with a capital Letter
4. End with proper punctuation (., ?, !)
