

Assessment Task: Wedding Escape Scene Analysis

Students will work in pairs or small groups to select a short scene from a movie or drama where a bride or groom refuses, interrupts, or runs away from a wedding.

Each group will present the video clip (30–90 seconds maximum) to the class, followed by a short explanation.

Required Components

Your presentation must include:

1. Scene Summary (1–2 minutes)
 - Who is in the scene?
 - What is happening in the wedding?
 - What is the main conflict?
2. Reason for Leaving (2–3 minutes)
 - Why did the bride or groom run away or refuse the wedding?
 - Explain at least two influencing factors, such as:
 - family expectations
 - cultural traditions
 - personal goals
 - fear or pressure
 - identity or independence
3. Theory Connection (1 theory minimum)
 - Connect the situation to at least one relationship theory, such as:
 - Conflict Theory
 - Feminist Theory
 - Sociocultural Theory
 - Humanist Theory
 - Explain how the theory helps explain the character's decision.

4. Conclusion (1 minute)

- What does this situation show about relationships, marriage, or adulthood?
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
